West Northfield School District 31 will provide free breakfast and lunch to students during the school closure and through the summer months.

Beginning May 27, 2020, students can pick up pre-packaged meals from the MAIN ENTRANCE OF:

**\*\*\*\*Glenbrook South High School - 4000 W. Lake Ave, Glenview – Main Entrance\*\*\*\***

**Wednesday, May 27, 2020 8AM – 12 PM – Students will be provided (4) breakfasts and (4) lunches**

**Every Monday – 8AM – 12PM – Students will be provided (2) breakfasts and (2) lunches**

**Every Wednesday – 8AM – 12PM – Students will be provided (3) breakfasts and (3) lunches**
