Equity should be the foundation of what we do for ALL students. It urges us to consider our philosophies and practices with an equity lens. From a keen understanding to a student(s) cultural background and experiences to learning how we can deconstruct implicit biases and become aware of daily microaggressions, equity ensures that we embrace, validate and affirm all the identities of self while transforming toward an equitable system.

In this one-hour session, participants develop common language and understanding regarding equity, diversity, and inclusion. Participants will also explore interactive and structured conversation on culture and the cultural proficiency continuum to deepen the learning of equity.
